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**INVITING APPLICATIONS FOR AUTHORISATION OF CHARTERED  
ELECTRICAL SAFETY ENGINEER (CESE) IN THE STATE OF HARYANA.**

**Date of Publication: 07.03.2019**

**Opening date of Registration of online application: 11.03.2019**

**Closing date of Registration of online application: 31.03.2019**

**Last date for submission of fees: 03.04.2019**

Online applications are invited from eligible engineers, retirees as well as retired CEI/EI to authorize them as Chartered Electrical Safety Engineers under regulation 5A of the Central Electricity Authority (Measures relating to Safety and Electric Supply) Amendment Regulations, 2018. The authorization of existing CESEs will automatically be cancelled after authorization of CESEs on the basis of test and, however, existing authorized Chartered Electrical Safety Engineers will have to appear in the written test. The eligibility conditions for getting the authorization to work as Chartered Electrical Safety Engineers are under:-

**1. Qualifications:**

- (i) He/she should possess a regular degree in electrical engineering or equivalent degree from a recognized University established or incorporated by or under a Central or State Act or an institution recognized by the University Grants Commissions under the University Grants Commissions Act, 1956 and approved by the AICTE with at least 5 years of experience in operation and maintenance of electrical installations with documentary proof. **However, he/she will have to produce equivalency certificate from AICTE/AIU in support of his/her above mentioned qualification at the time of scrutinizing the documents.**

**OR**

- He/she should possess a diploma in Electrical Engineering with at least 10 years of experience in operation and maintenance of electrical installations.
- (ii) He/she should also have the knowledge of the works related to observance of electrical safety regulations.
- (iii) In addition to the knowledge of Electrical subjects, he/she should have the knowledge of Central Electricity Authority (Measures relating to Safety and Electric Supply) Regulations, 2010 (as amended) and other relevant Act and Regulation related to electricity supply in the State of Haryana.
- (iv) He/she should not hold any post in Govt. /Semi Govt. /PSUs or associated with any organizations which directly or indirectly influence the working of CESE.
- (v) He/she should belong to the Haryana/UT Chandigarh and will have to produce valid proof i.e. Aadhar Card.

**2. Fees Details:**

- (i) Rs. 1000/- (Rs. One thousand only) as a non-refundable examination fees by Challan/E-payment, in any branch of the State Bank of India from 11.03.2019 to 03.04.2019 will be deposited by the applicant for appearing in the examination.

- (ii) The applicant, who clears the examination, will have to deposit one time registration fees of Rs. 10,000/- (Rs. Ten thousand only) in the “**Head of Accounts: 0043-51-800-99-51—Other Receipt**” for authorising as CESE as mentioned at point No. 8(c) of the said guidelines.
- (iii) The tenure of the CESE shall be for the period of three years initially, which can be extended for further two years on the basis of performance or as per instructions amended from time to time.

### **3. Age:**

- (i) He/she (New and retirees) has attained the minimum age of 26 years and the maximum age limit for appearing in the examination will be 62 years as on 01.04.2019.
- (ii) The maximum age for working as CESE will be 65 years.

### **4. Procedure/Instruction:**

- (i) The application for authorization and taking written examination does not entitle a candidate to get authorisation as CESE. The authorisation shall be granted on the basis of getting 50% marks in the written test and verification of documents pertaining to eligibility criteria. The test will be objective type (in English medium only) for 3 hours duration having 200 multiple choice questions. Each correct answer will carry plus 4 marks and wrong answer will carry minus 1 marks. The centre for the test will be at Chandigarh only. The name of the authorised CESEs shall be uploaded on the departmental website for accessibility to the consumers.
- (ii) The candidates must read the Central Electricity Authority (Measures relating to Safety and Electric Supply) Amendment Regulations, 2018 regarding authorising the CESE issued by the Central Electricity Authority dated 21.06.2018 before applying for written test and he/she should fulfill the criteria as prescribed in the advertisement as well as in the said guidelines/regulations.
- (iii) All necessary documents required for authorization as CESE, will have to be produced at the time of scrutiny after passing the written examination failing which the candidature will be summarily rejected.
- (iv) However, existing CESEs suspended/cancelled earlier due to willful negligence, mal-practice, misuse or any other activities affecting the safety of electrical installations, and retirees awarded punishment by his parent department or under any vigilance/departmental enquiry will not be eligible to apply for written test.
- (v) In case of non-qualifying the above examination or non-attempt of examination or any short comings in documents pertaining to eligibility, the authorization of existing CESEs shall be cancelled automatically.

### **5. Fake Institution:**

- (i) Candidates, who have obtained degrees or diplomas in Electrical Engineering from any institution declared fake by the UGC or not recognized by Haryana Government, shall not be eligible for being considered for authorisation as CESE and no representation in this regard shall be entertained.

### **6. Action against candidates found guilty of misconduct:**

- (i) Candidates are warned that they should not furnish any particulars that are false, tampered/fabricated or should not suppress any material information while filling up the application form.

- (ii) At the time of examination/scrutiny, if a candidate is (or has been) found guilty of: (i) using unfair means during the examination or (ii) impersonating or procuring impersonation by any person or (iii) misbehaving in the examination hall or leaving the examination hall without permission or (iv) resorting to any irregular or improper means in connection with his/her candidature for selection or (v) obtaining support for his/her candidature by any unfair means (vi) not complying with instructions issued from time to time, such a candidate may, in addition to rendering himself/herself liable to criminal prosecution, be liable:-
- a. to be disqualified from the examination/scrutiny for which he/she is a candidate.
  - b. to be debarred either permanently or for a specified period, from examination for authorisation as CESE in future.

**7. Documents to be brought at the time of scrutiny/authorisation:-**

- (i) All original certificates/documents/testimonials of educational qualifications and other documents mentioned in the online application and one set of self attested copies of all these certificates i.e. matric, diploma/degree, aadhaar, experience certificate, order of retirement (in case of retiree), equivalency certificate issued by AICTE/AIU.
- (ii) Printed copy of online application form alongwith latest stamp size photograph duly attested by a gazetted officer and pasted on the application form alongwith date on photograph.
- (iii) Original proof of earlier fees deposited i.e. Treasury Challan/ Credit Certificate issued by concerned treasury etc.

**8. Likely causes of rejection of application:**

The following are likely causes of rejection:-

- (i) More than one application form.
- (ii) Application is incomplete and not online.
- (iii) Full fee, if not deposited in the manner prescribed.
- (iv) No essential qualification as prescribed in advertisement.
- (v) Application does not indicate visible identification mark in appropriate column of application form.
- (vi) Candidate is underage/overage on the closing date.
- (vii) Variation in date of online application form and in original documents when brought for verification/scrutiny.
- (viii) Candidates indulge in any willful negligence, mal-practice, misuse or any other activities affecting the safety of electrical installations (in case of existing CESE).
- (ix) Existing CESE, whose authorisation has been suspended/cancelled.

**9. Other qualifications:**

He/she shall for all time in his possession have the basic testing equipments as prescribed in **Annexure-I** of the said Amendment Regulations, 2018 for testing of the electrical installations.
